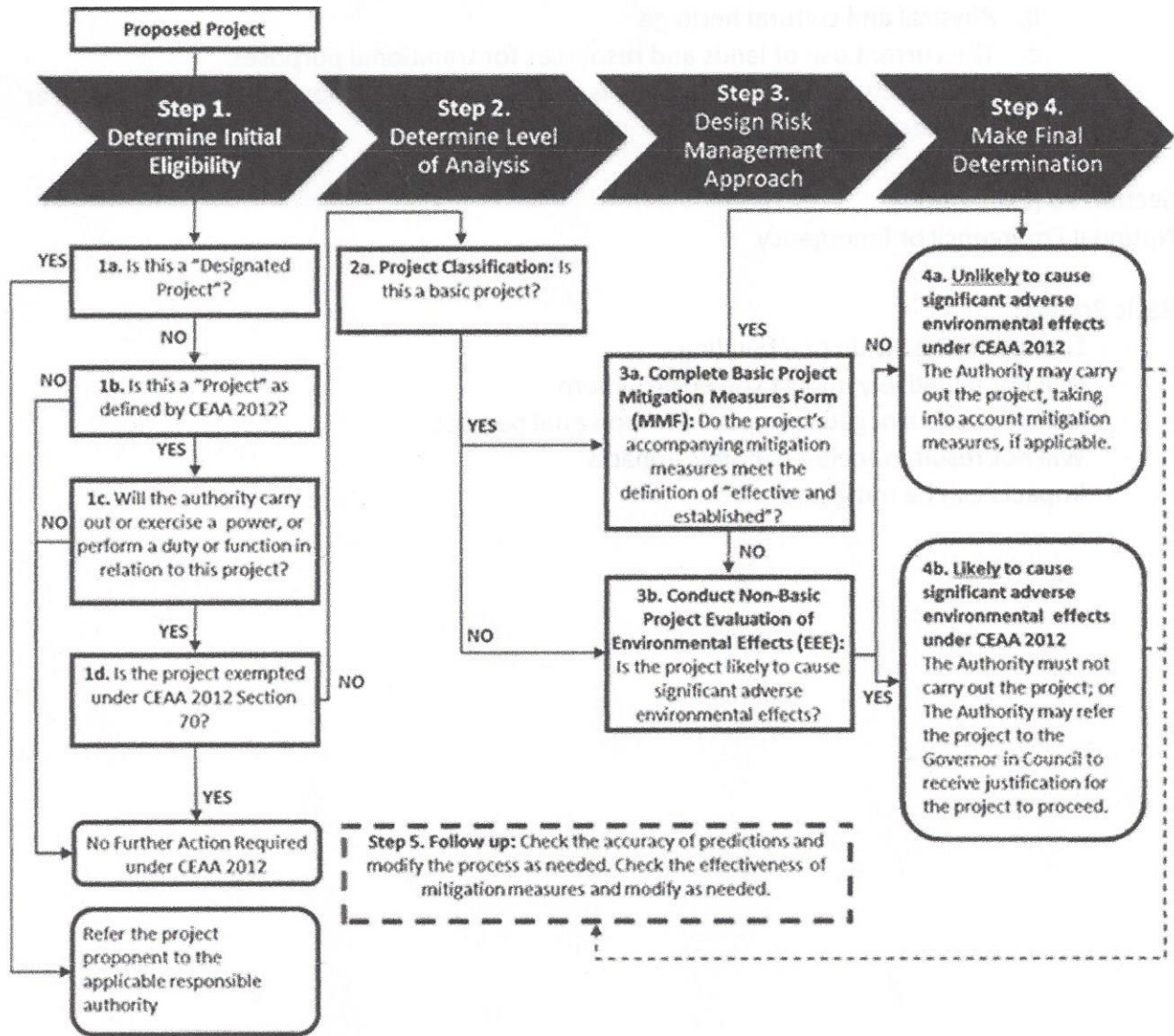

## Overview of the current EA Process



### Designated Project:

- a) Carried out in Canada on Federal lands
- b) Are designated by regulations made by (Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission, National Energy Board, any federal authority that performs regulatory functions, the CEAA)

### Project:

- a) A change that may be caused to the following components of the environment that are within the legislative authority of parliament (fish and fisheries, migratory birds)
- b) A change that may be caused to the environment on federal lands or in a province where effects will be seen other than where the project is.

- c) With respect to aboriginal lands, an effect occurring in Canada of any change that may be caused to the environment on:
- a. Health and socio-economic conditions
  - b. Physical and cultural heritage
  - c. The current use of lands and resources for traditional purposes
  - d. Any structure, site or thing that is of historical archaeological, paleontological or architectural significance.

Section 70 (Exemption):  
National Emergency or Emergency

Basic Project:

- Limited to the inside of a building
- Will not negatively impact the environment
- Will not have a negative impact on Aboriginal peoples
- Will not result in socio-economic impacts
- Impacts can be mitigated
