Wind project to be discussed via Six Nations community engagement process

Six Nations of Grand River Territory – Six Nations Elected Council is pleased to announce the launch of a community engagement process for the Niagara Region Wind Project located in the Township of West Lincoln, Town of Lincoln (Niagara Region) and Haldimand County.

This project will be comprised of 77 turbines, generating 230 megawatts in renewable energy which will be sold to the Ontario Power Authority under the FIT1.0 program. The projects will be owned and operated by Daniels Power, Enercon Canada Inc. and Boralex Inc. An equity ownership of the project is being contemplated The Six Nations of the Grand River Development Corporation.

The community engagement process has been designed to educate the Six Nations community about the financial, economic, and environmental impact associated with the projects, and provides a community wide mechanism to gather feedback that will help guide decision-making now and in the future.

The community engagement process will run from June 22 to July 17, 2015. There will be two community meetings; the first is scheduled for June 25th, which will include dinner! The community meeting will provide further information and will include the opportunity for community members to have one-on-one discussions with staff.
