NANTICOKE SOLAR

Project Information

The Independent Electricity Systems Operator (IESO) awarded a 20-year Large Renewable Procurement (LRP I) contract to Nanticoke Solar LP to develop and operate a 44 MW ground-mounted solar project consisting of the installation of solar photovoltaic (PV) panels on 4 parcels of land. This project will be located on and adjacent to the former coal burning, Nanticoke Generating Station, located in Nanticoke, ON.

Nanticoke Solar LP, is a partnership between:

- Ontario Power Generation Inc. (90%)
- Six Nations of the Grand River Development Corporation (10%)

Project Status:

- Stage 1 and Stage 2 archaeology work has been completed.
- A total of 7 archaeological locations will require further investigations via Stage 3 Archaeological Assessment. It is expected that Stage 4 Archaeological Mitigation will be required for some of the archaeological sites subject to Stage 3 assessment.
- Construction is planned to start Fall 2017.
- The Milestone Commercial Operation Date (MCOD) is anticipated for March 2019.

Community Benefits

- Six Nations of the Grand River Development Corporation (SNGRDC) has invested in the project to hold a 10% equity ownership as a Limited Partner.
- Project financing will be provided by way of an Equity Bridge Agreement from OPG (where OPG fronts the capital investment on behalf of SNGRDC and re-payment of the loan begins once the project reaches commercial operation).
- SNGRDC has the right to replace the Equity Bridge with its own financing at commercial operation.
- SNGRDC's investment is estimated to generate no less than \$7 million over 20 years.
- Potential employment opportunities may be available through the contractor.

FACT

1 Approximately 170 trades people will be employed at the peak of construction.

2 This project will utilize 175,000 to 210,000 solar panels and will be connected to a 230kV Transmission System.

3 Six Nations archeological monitors have been engaged throughout the assessments.
